Gospel Matt (22:1-14) You are invited!

This parable tells us that the Kingdom of God is not a prerogative of some people (neither Jew nor Gentile). ALL are invited into the Kingdom of God regardless of race and status. Therefore, nothing should prevent us from responding to God's invitation. "For What does it profit a man if he should gain the whole world and lose his soul" (Mk8:36). Nevertheless, there is always a basic requirement (cf. the man without the wedding garment). The "dress code" for the Kingdom requires that one behave like a child of the kingdom.
