Today’s Gospel reminds us of our duties as citizens and our obligations to God. Thus, we are citizens of the world and citizens of Heaven. We have an obligation to each. But when the obligations clash what do we do? The answer is: We must resolve them as Thomas More did, without compromise to our God or conscience.
